

Installation guide – Removable Pool Safety Fencing

At each right angle, it is imperative to install 2 stakes linked with a security latch to dispatch structure tension and solidify the structure as a whole.

- If you have planned a partial installation (an L shape, for example), the stake positioned at the extremity of the installation must be anchored to a fixed point, for example, a wall.

- All fitting sleeves must be stuck onto the ground surface (paving or wood) or concrete studs when installation is carried out on an earth surface with a strong, epoxy glue.



Measure the barrier periphery according to your pool dimensions. Clearly trace the line of stakes and the exact position of drilling holes.



Drill the hole with 16 mm drill bit. Vacuum the dust from the hole and position the sleeve. The sleeves will be glued only when the totality of the fencing system has been positioned and installed.



Insert the first stake into the positioned sleeve. Firmly pull the module by the lower hem as to extend tension. Position and mark the next stake position. Repeat the operation to trace the totality of your modules.



Create the drilling hole of the 2-nd module 6 cm between the axis and the next stake. Insert the stake and fit its sleeve. Position the safety latch and repeat this process. The rounded side of the section must be positioned towards the exterior of the pool. The latch must face inwards, towards the pool.



If you need to adjust the screw on the last stake. Position the stake as desired, equally paying attention to the netting tension by adjusting with top and bottom screws. The hem will no longer be positioned on the lateral side of the netting. This does not have an incidence on the esthetic or technical aspect of the fencing system.



Anchor the floor plates using screw plugs (not supplied). You can adjust the notch situated on the floor plate, safety latch side, as to reduce the space between the lateral stake and the gate . This avoids a child trying to pass a hand to open the latch.
